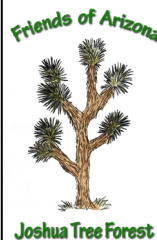

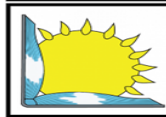

The Recording Division assists all residents with the recording of property related documents. This can stem from deeds, liens, mortgages and court documents. The Mohave County Recorder's Office has implemented a new practice of providing documents immediately at the time of recording, rather than returning the recorded documents by mail. Please provide the Mohave County Assessor 8-10 weeks for the ownership to be updated on their website. 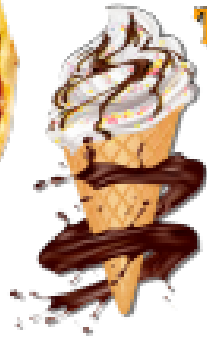
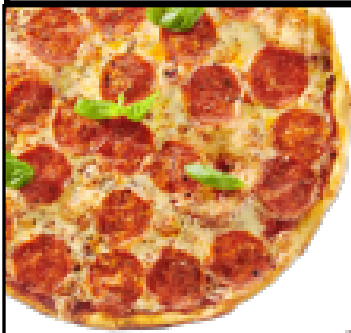

This will inform us of any voter movement and can help keep Mohave County's voter rolls clean! If any changes need to be made to your voter registration record, or if you would like to become a registered voter in Mohave County, you may choose to register to vote online through www.servicearizona.com, pick up a paper form in our offices, or call or email our main office to mail you a form. A voter registration form can be used to update information in your record such as your name, mailing address, party affiliation and signature for ballot verification.

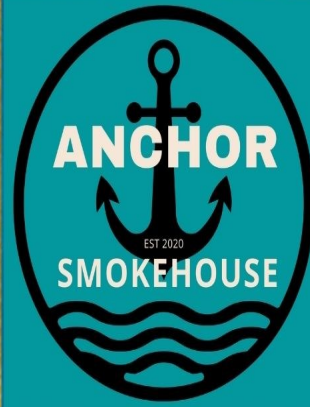

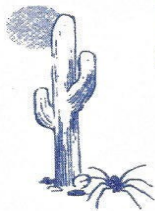
