OUT WITH THE OLD AND IN WITH THE NEW Cheers to 2024

January 1 marks the start of another trip around the sun. All over the world, people welcome the new year with hope and anticipation of a better year. People are making New Year's Resolutions with the hope that by keeping them, their lives will improve. As we embrace the new year with anticipation and hope of great things to happen, the words "new" and "first" will keep popping up.

In the sports world, 2024 offers two Olympic games. The opening ceremonies of the 4th Winter Youth Olympics will take place on January 19. For the next 13 days, 1900 athletes from the ages 15-18 will compete for coveted Gold, Silver and Bronze metals. Then on July 26, the 33rd Summer Olympics will open in Paris, France. 10,500 athletes will compete in 32 different sports in 329 events. This will be the first Olympics in which men and women will compete against each other.

Superbowl LVIII will be held in the Allegiant Stadium in Las Vegas. This will be the first time a Superbowl game has been played in Nevada. The playoffs start January 13.

This is a Presidential Election year and Mohave County voters will go to the polls on August 6 for the Primary Election and November 5 for the General Election. Most government offices are up for election in 2024. COM will host a Candidate Forum on Sunday, June 23 so voters in the Meadview area will be able to meet the candidates well in advance of the Primary Election.

The UniSource Sub-Station has been completed and we can expect it to be put into operation soon. This project was created to improve electric service to the Meadview Area and this is a great way to start the new year.

Meadview continues to thrive and real estate sales are still strong. Most buyers are making Meadview a full time residence. In 2023, we welcomed many new businesses in the area and hope this trend continues. Our churches and organizations have new activities and plans for 2024. The January COM Meeting will host a "Mega Group Report" to allow organizations to present their plans for 2024. Marinas/Ramps/Harbors/Beaches

South Cove launching is available off the dirt road south of the launch ramp. Four-wheel-drive recommended. Launch at your own risk.

Katherine Landing Fishing Pier is closed until further notice.

Temple Bar Marina—Temple Bar has installed a portable Mobi-Mat for boat launching managed by the marina. They currently recommend launching boats smaller than 40 feet. Please contact 928-767-3211 with any questions. Regular hours for the fuel dock are from 8 a.m.—4 p.m. The store is open daily from 8 a.m.—5 p.m. The motel is open, but the restaurant is closed for the season.

Willow Beach Marina—The store and marina are open from 8 a.m.—4 p.m., seven days a week. Black Canyon Grill is closed through March 01, 2024.




