#### **SPOTLIGHT ON TURNING 105 YEARS OLD IN 2025**

In honor of Lucille Sunde's 105th trip around the sun on August 4, we are putting the spotlight on what it means to reach 105 years old in 2025. By making it to 105, Lucille has become a member of a very exclusive group of people. As of 2021, the number of 105 year-old people living in the United States is estimated to be around 6,000. Living to be 105 has also given Lucille the distinction of being the longest living person in the recorded history of Meadview.

Lucille made her debut at the beginning of the Roaring Twenties, which also marked the beginning of Prohibition with passage of the 18th Amendment that wasn't repealed until 1933. For the first nine years, she lived in flourishing times with high employment and people living lavishly. And then BOOM, the Great Depression hit in 1929. This cycle of good times/bad times has been repeated many times in 105 years.

Woodrow Wilson was President when Lucille was born. Since then, there have been 19 different Presidents serving in 26 terms. By the way, in Lucille's birth year of 1920, women were first granted the right to vote when the 19th Amendment was ratified on August 18. Her comment about this was "I guess my fate was cast."

Lucille shares the 105 year mark with Good Humor Ice Cream Bars, Band-aids and Baby Ruth Candy Bars. The first automobiles were quite expensive and only the very wealthy owned cars. In 1918, only one family in 13 owned an automobile. However, in 1920 Henry Ford was able to produce the Ford Model T that sold for \$310 making car ownership more affordable. Lucille continued to drive in Meadview until she was 100 years old.

WWII brought dramatic change when women were called upon to work in factories replacing the men who went off to war. The term Rosie the Riveter was created to describe these new factory workers who worked assembly lines to supply items needed to fight the war. And our own Lucille was one of these "essential" workers of those times. At one time she also worked as a Hostess for Bullocks-Wilshire, a job more fitting of the very gracious Lucille than Rosie the Riveter.

Being a very happy person has carried Lucille through some tough times such as when her house here in Meadview burned on her birthday while she was fishing in the Utah mountains. Happiness and attitude also helped in her recovery from a broken hip shortly before her 100th birthday. She fought hard to recover in time to attend many parties in her honor. And COVID-19 didn't hold her down. Lucille's strength is amazing. Through Lucille's Meadview life, she has been a very active member of the Community. She was responsible for opening up King Tut to Pierce Ferry Road, was President of Quail, President of CFIC, Vice President of COM, a member of DAR and the Over-The-Hill Hikers later known as The Explorers.

Dearest Lucille, we hope you had a wonderful birthday. Here's to 105 and counting.

We recently had a pipe break that drained the entire 125,000 gallon tank. I did not find out about it until a little after 4:00 am. **PLEASE** call if you notice your water pressure low and you think it's not normal. We would much rather get up in the middle of the night

than lose all the water in the system. We had a few last summer where someone didn't have water, but didn't want to bother anyone that late at night. We rely on our customers to let us know about leaks. It is kind of an outdated way of doing it, but it is the way it has been done for years.

We are working on a more modern way of letting us know conditions in the system, but that will take some time. So PLEASE, PLEASE, PLEASE call if you have no water or your pressure seems lower than normal. Do not worry if it's the middle of the night.



# COUNTY CORNER

Hello Mohave County. This month's County Corner will be focusing on growth in Mohave County. I thought it would be interesting to compare improvements from 20 years ago to today.

Let's start with Single Family Residences (SFR's).

In 2005 Mohave County had 48,758 SFR's.

In 2015 Mohave County had 61,485 SFR's.

In 2020 Mohave County had 66,128 SFR's.

Today Mohave County has 75,393 SFR's

This growth equals to a 55% increase of Single-Family Residences in Mohave County in the last 20 years.

Now let's move to Multi Family Residences (MFR's)

In 2005 Mohave County had 1,186 MFR's.

In 2015 Mohave County had 1,320 MFR's.

In 2020 Mohave County had 1,401 MFR's.

Today Mohave County has 1,846 MFR's.

This equals to a 56% increase of Multi-Family Residences in Mohave County in the last 20 years.

Moving on to Commercial improvements (this number excludes Restaurants).

In 2005 Mohave County had 4,205 Commercial improvements.

In 2015 Mohave County had 5,308 Commercial improvements.

In 2020 Mohave County had 6,106 Commercial improvements.

Today Mohave County has 11,602 Commercial improvements.

This Commercial growth is fantastic at 176% increase since 2005.

Restaurant growth (numbers below do not reflect fast foods).

In 2005 Mohave County had 122 Restaurants.

In 2015 Mohave County had 146 Restaurants.

In 2020 Mohave County had 189 Restaurants.

Today Mohave County has 189 Restaurants.

## Restaurants have increased by 55%

These numbers tell a story about the growth of Mohave County. Your taxes are calculated by all property owners paying for a slice of the Mohave County pie, the more taxpayers that come to our county the smaller your slice of the pie. Thus, these numbers are very promising. Growth is always good for us when it comes to property taxes. When there are more people fighting for that slice of pie, it costs less.
