

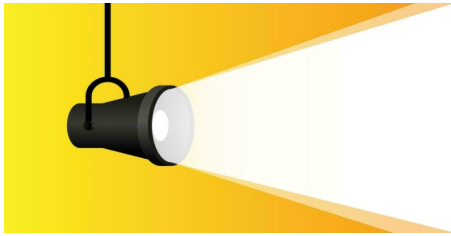

Summer is coming and several Meadview businesses have recently posted their summer hours. And the Anchor Smokehouse announced that it has reopened just in time for the summer season.

Taking a break from the day-to-day business operation, enabled owners, Robert and Laura Herrera the time to work on some changes they wanted to offer including a new specialized menu. Some of the popular pizzas are an all-meat Carnivore pizza, Veggie Pizza with topping choices of peppers, mushrooms, black olives, onion and tomatoes. The Hawaiian pizza can be ordered with ham and pineapple or with pepperoni and pineapple. There is a 9” personal pizza with any three toppings for \$9.99. Laura is working on creating a white sauce pizza. There will be specials such as the Spaghetti dinner for \$8.99 this Sunday.

Celebrate the Anchor Smokehouse re-opening and Cinco de Mayo on May 2 and 3. They will be featuring a special menu with traditional Mexican favorites and special margaritas.

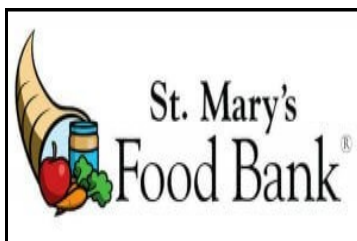

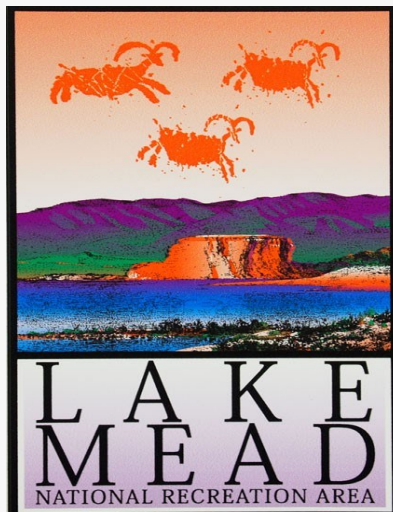

The NHL playoffs started this past weekend. The Vegas Golden Knights made the playoffs and they are playing Utah Mammoth in the first round.

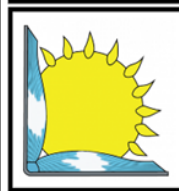

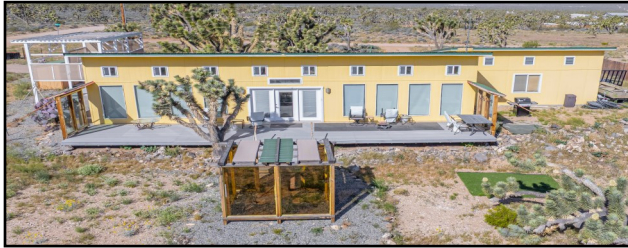

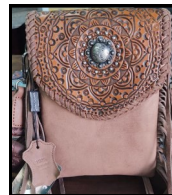
