



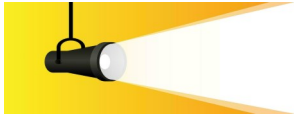

## SPOTLIGHT ON ELECTION 2026 AND THE MEADVIEW CANDIDATE FORUM



On July 4, 2026, we will celebrate the 250th birthday of the United States. The basis of the American Revolution was being governed without representation or a voice and the theme of the war was "taxation without representation". The outcome of the war was that the colonists of the United States of America were given a voice in government through voting. And now we are celebrating 250 years of Americans being privileged to exercise their right to vote for the candidates who run for Federal, State, County and Special Districts elections.

This year we will be voting in what is called Midterm Elections. On the Federal level, the 2026 midterm elections will shape the final two years of the current presidential administration. Voters will decide on the control of Congress since all of the U.S. House of Representatives seats are up for election along with 1/3 of the U.S. Senate seats,

At the Federal level In Mohave County, we will be voting for candidates for the office of U.S. House of Representatives. At the State level, candidates are running for Governor, Secretary of State, State Treasurer, Superintendent of Public Instruction, State Mine Inspector. We will also be voting for legislative candidates for the Arizona Senate and State Representatives for LD30. Mohave County officials all hold four-year terms and are elected in the years of presidential elections. However, there will be elections for Special Districts in Mohave County such as three members of the LMRFD Fire Board.

The Arizona Primary election will be July 21. The last date to register to vote in the primary is June 22. Early Voting will begin on June 22. The last date to vote early in person is July 17. September 19 is the last date to register to vote in the General Election which is November 3.

For many years, COM has sponsored a Candidate Form and Meet 'N Greet. It is our goal to bring the candidates to the community so our voters can meet them and know how they stand on the issues that impact Meadview. All candidates are invited and the event is open to the public. This year the Candidate Forum will be Saturday, June 20 in the MCA Auditorium from 1:00 pm—4:00 pm. The doors will open at 12:30 pm. This date was selected so the Candidate Forum will take place before the Primary Election and Early Voting begins so our voters can be informed about the candidates.

The forum will be moderated by Connie Hargreaves. Each candidate will be given an opportunity to introduce themselves and tell us their qualifications to run for the position. After the introductions, Connie will ask questions of all the candidates that are area specific and address issues of concern for Meadview area residents. During the forum portion of the event, no questions will be asked by the audience. However, you will have ample time to meet with the candidates individually and ask your own questions before and after the forum.

Please take the time to attend the Candidate Forum so you can be an informed voter in this historical election year. It is a privilege and honor to be able to vote in the year that marks 250 years of voting in a democracy. By exercising your right to vote, you are preserving the beliefs and ideals on which this great county was created. We need to remind ourselves that in many areas of the world, people are not so fortunate. **Vote Smart/Vote 2026 Midterm.**

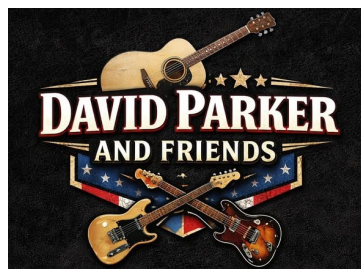

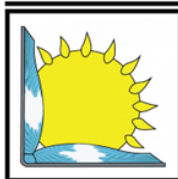

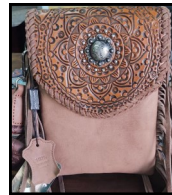
