SPOTLIGHT ON COM, THE VOICE OF MEADVIEW

When newcomers come to the Meadview area, one of the first things they become aware of is that Meadview is a community that depends on volunteers. One of those volunteer organizations is COM or the Community Organization of Meadview. COM is a unique organization because every resident is a member just by owning property in the Meadview area without membership fees.

COM is considered the "Voice of Meadview" by sponsoring the Community News that is published bi-monthly for 26 issues each year. COM also conducts the monthly COM Meetings on the 1st Thursday of each month from September through May. The meetings also provide an opportunity for all groups, churches and organizations to give a report on what is happening or events that are planned. Our meetings will resume on September 3 and our main speaker will be Lt. Steve Padilla of the Mohave County Sheriff's Department. And we just might have a surprise visit from a special guest. You don't want to miss this one.

As you travel on Stockton Hill Road or Pierce Ferry you will notice signs identifying Litter Control volunteer groups who maintain each of those 2 mile sections. COM organizes all of these highway pick-up sections and works closely with the county for the success of the Litter Control Program. Currently, there are 28 groups that keep our roads clean and all are managed through COM. Twice a year, Karen Stacy works with the various groups and individuals to schedule their pick-up times. As soon as the weather cools off, they will begin to schedule the Fall pick-ups. With Karen and Carl Stacy's assistance, COM also works with the county to schedule the annual large bin trash pick-up and recruits a team of volunteers to assure this event is successful. Watch for the announcement of when the 2026 pick-up will take place. We have also partnered with the National Park Service in their highway trash pick up activity. The Park Service plans to organize the clean-up of Pierce Ferry Road from Family Dollar to the lake access road for the third time this Fall. Watch for the announcement when this clean-up will be scheduled.

COM works closely with county agencies so they are aware of issues affecting Meadview such as maintaining our roads especially during the monsoon season. We invite county and state government officials to attend our COM Meetings so they know the needs of the community.

COM is responsible for maintaining the Welcome to Meadview Sign Complex. COM's Litter Control area is Meadview Boulevard from Pierce Ferry to Haystack. We do trash pick-up of this area in the spring and fall. We will announce the date of our fall pick-up at the October COM Meeting.

While all these activities are a lot of work, we find time for fun, too. In December, COM organizes the Christmas Caravan that is a guided tour of homes decorated for Christmas. At each monthly COM Meeting, we try to include some form of entertainment. And we try to have some type of surprise for the audience attending the meetings.

COM is always looking for new volunteers. At each meeting be sure to check out the clipboard sign-up sheets located on the table at the auditorium door. The elections for the new board will be held at the December meeting. If you have an interest to be on this board, please let a current board member know.

We look forward to seeing you all at the September 3 Meeting.
