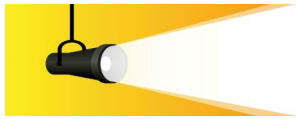

SPOTLIGHT ON THE SEPTEMBER COM MEETING AND THE NEWLY CREATED NORTHWEST DISTRICT OF MCSO

Speakers at the September COM Meeting presented a lot of important information about what is happening in Meadview. There is a new interim pastor at the Meadview Community Church, a fund raiser Brunch for the Fire District will be held on October 10 and the Large Bin Pick up will be November 14. We also set a new record for attendance at a September meeting with 92 folks in the audience. Karen Stacy reported that 89 folks participated in the Large Bin Pickup last November and the September Meeting attendance beat that number by three.

The main speaker at the September COM Meeting was Lt. Steve Padilla of the Mohave County Sheriff's Office. Lt. Padilla announced the creation of the new Northwest District. Lt. Padilla introduced six members of the Northwest Unit Squad: Deputies Hake, Stucki, Taylor, Graham, Martin and Schiller. The new district covers Golden Valley, Chloride, Dolan Springs, White Hills, Meadview and the North Highway 93 corridor to the Nevada State Line. The Northwest District will be overseen by Lieutenant Padilla and Sergeant McCool, who is also one of the K-9 handlers.



As Mohave County rural communities continue to grow, so does the demand for law enforcement services. The Northwest District was created in response to population growth and increased calls for service throughout the northern portion of Mohave County. The new district will allow the Sheriff's Office to dedicate greater attention and resources to the communities they serve.

The Sheriff's Office feels maintaining strong relationships with the rural communities is essential to effective law enforcement. Their continued involvement and support helps to better understand and respond to the needs of each community. The attendance of 92 people at the meeting is an indication of the support shown by the community.

Mohave County is experiencing rapid growth and the Sheriff's Office is growing with it. There are now six more recruits being trained at the academy. Another four more deputies will be joining the Sheriff's Department laterally moved from other law enforcement agencies. The Board of Supervisors has approved the funding to make the expansion of the Sheriff's Department personnel possible and the formation of the Northwest District.

A big shout-out goes to the Meadview area residents for the strong turnout at our September COM Meeting. We look forward to seeing you all at the October 1 COM Meeting.

As we enter September, we're pleased to share updates from the Recorder's Office and important election information. We also pause to remember September 11, 2001, honoring those who lost their lives and those who responded with courage.

The Mohave County Recorder's Office continues to improve access to public records. Our Recording Division manually indexes documents and recently added a verification process to improve accuracy and retrievability. Beginning August 3, 2026, individuals submitting documents for recording in person must provide valid photo identification. This change helps strengthen the recording process and ensure documents are submitted by authorized individuals.

The Recorder's Office recently celebrated the two-year anniversary of its free Recorded Document Alert System, which notifies residents when a document is recorded under their name or associated with their property. We also encourage veterans to take advantage of free DD214 recording for the safekeeping of these important military records. For questions, contact (928) 753-0701 or RecorderHelp@mohave.gov.

Voter Registration: The Voter Registration Division is preparing for the General Election and reminds voters to make sure their registration information is current. The registration deadline is Monday, October 5, and early voting begins Wednesday, October 7. Residents can help keep voter rolls accurate by writing "Return to Sender" on election mail addressed to someone who no longer lives at their address or has passed away and returning it through the mail. 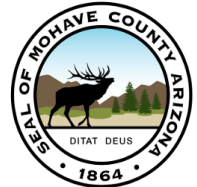

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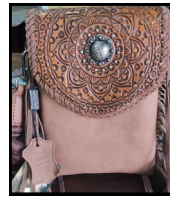
